## Unrestricted Electives

Students who begin Spanish at a higher level than SPAN 1011 Elementary Spanish I will receive additional unrestricted electives. They should

consider taking additional upper-level Spanish courses such as SPAN 2111 Advanced Spanish I or SPAN 2112 Advanced Spanish II.

Students should consider beginning work on minor requirements of some CSUs. They may also complete other General Education requirements (for CCSU, WCSU, SCSU, and CO-but **not** ECSU).
